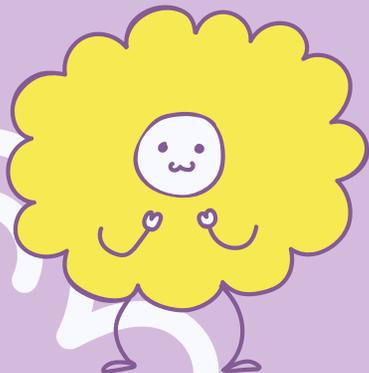
DEMENTIA BEHAVIORAL SUPPORT PROGRAM





We provide free education & training

Each person with dementia has a unique experience and faces different challenges.



What we do:

1. learn about the person from those involved
2. meet the person
3. observe interactions and care
4. develop life story book, if appropriate
5. suggest environmental changes
6. provide tools that help with safety, communication, & stress reduction
7. make suggestions about approach and communication
8. consult with geriatric psychiatrist as needed
9. offer training for providers of care
10. make recommendations for ongoing dementia care



Dementia behaviors & stabilization

- ★ We help people who have been given a 30-day notice from a facility due to behavioral expressions.
- ★ We work with people with dementia who are experiencing behavioral changes that may put them or others at risk.

Intense behaviors that can lead to crisis situations are often the result of fear.
